# Each school review generates a number of key improvement strategies to inform continuous improvement in all state schools. The next steps are...

- Collaborate with school staff, the P&C and client schools to develop a vision for the future of the centre incorporating the developing curriculum and pedagogy initiatives, and partnership opportunities.
- Develop opportunities for centre teachers to collaboratively develop curriculum programs with cluster and client schools to identify what sections of the Australian Curriculum standard, learning intention and success criteria are best covered at the centre.
- Further develop teacher understanding of utilising an inquiry framework to enrich curriculum delivery, empowering further student ownership of their learning journey.
- Establish priority agendas that reflect the core work of the centre and are mapped through timelines, targets and strategies to systematically evaluate the effectiveness of initiatives and programs on improving student learning and wellbeing outcomes.
- Explore opportunities to work with client schools and visiting teachers to determine assessable elements of a unit and the support role centre teachers can have in gathering data on student progress.
